- WHAT: Tagging for Sheep, Swine, Meat Goat & Market Dairy Wethers
  - All market lambs, market meat goats, and market swine must be brought to the Extension Office at the scheduled time. Commercial swine operations whose biosecurity plan prevents them from taking swine off the farm, please contact the Extension Office to schedule a time to tag prior to April 21<sup>st</sup>.
  - > All market dairy weathers see special note below

LOCATION:Butler County Extension Office (see attached map for traffic flow. MUST FOLLOW this route!)DATE & TIME:Sunday, April 21st - 3:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

All livestock must be tagged according to tagging guidelines in order to be eligible to show at the Butler County Fair.

- Special note for Market Dairy Wethers
  - Must be 100% dairy AND complete the Market Dairy Wether ID Form
    - Boer-Dairy crosses must tag as a market meat goat during the tagging time above.
  - Forms may be turned into the Butler County Extension Office prior to the April 21st tagging event OR during tagging on April 21st between 3:00 and 6:00 p.m.
  - Original copies must be turned into the Extension Office. NO electronic copies will be accepted.
- June 13<sup>th</sup>: All Breeding Gilts (pedigreed and commercial), commercial ewes, and commercial meat goat does must be tagged by June 13<sup>th</sup>. You can either come to the above tagging date or call the Extension Office to schedule a time to bring them in to get tagged.
- Tag Cost: The tag cost will be \$3.00 and must be paid by cash or check at the time of tagging; please bring exact change.

#### **Requirements:**

- YQCA: YQCA is <u>REQUIRED</u> to be eligible to exhibit <u>ALL ANIMAL EXHIBITS</u> (Except Horses) at the 2024 Butler County Fair and must be completed by May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to be eligible to participate at the Butler County Fair. - ENROLLMENT: Please double check that your 4-Her ('s) are enrolled in 4-H for the 2023-2024 year and are also enrolled in the respective animal project by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
- TWO (2) FORMS FOR ALL MARKET ANIMALS: Animal Care & Housing and Owner Certification of Market Animals. Please refer to the enclosed packet and each form for additional information. Make sure all 4-H / FFA members and Parent/Guardians sign the form. Household nomination has been included with the Animal Care and Housing Form. Both of these forms can be completed and submitted electronically. ## **Small Animal Tagging Directions**

## Saturday, April 21<sup>st</sup> from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

#### Follow **GREEN** arrows for entrance directions. Follow **RED** arrows for exit directions.


- 1. Come in off Central and turn North on to Griffith St.
- 2. Turn into the Extension Office parking lot by the front of the building.
- 3. Drive between the Extension Office and the Community Building (marked by the star). Animals will be tagged here
- 4. Animals will be tagged between the Extension Office and the Community Building (marked by the star).
- 5. To exit, turn left between McDonald Stadium and the Extension Office.
- 6. When exiting, you must turn **<u>RIGHT</u>** onto North Griffith St. as to not disrupt the flow of traffic trying to enter to tag.

#### **REMINDERS:**

- All small market animals and bucket calves must be tagged during this scheduled time if you have not already tagged!
- DO NOT block the parking lot or entrance to Central Cinema.

## Animal Care and Housing for Butler County 4-H / FFA Animals

It is the responsibility of the 4-H / FFA member(s) to ensure that proper care is taken of their animal(s) by following acceptable methods of good animal husbandry. A healthy animal requires sufficient food, water, shelter, and appropriate health care. Specific animal husbandry guidelines and humane training methods are provided in 4-H / FFA manuals available upon request from the Butler County Extension Office. The Kansas 4-H / FFA Youth Development Policies, Best Management Practices, and Information states that "Youth should provide the primary care and training for livestock or animal projects for the duration of the project." Primary care is defined as the 4-H / FFA member(s) making the decisions for and/or providing the care, handling, and training of their animal project a majority of the time.

**Submission of this animal care document is required by** <u>all</u> **4-H** / **FFA animal project participants each year.** *This includes bucket calves, poultry, rabbits, and horses. It also includes beef, swine, meat goats, dairy goats, and sheep* 

Household Nominations for market and breeding animals						
Youth will be allowed to enter and show any animal that was nominated by their household according to the following restrictions:						
<ul> <li>Youth must all legally reside in the same household and share the same legal address.</li> <li>The youth entering the animal must have materially participated in the care of the project for the majority of the time.</li> </ul>						
- Youth will determine which animal they will exhibit at show check-in. (before weigh-in).						
- How the animal was nominated at tagging will decide whether the animal is shown as market or breeding. For example - a female tagged only as market will not be allowed to showed as breeding and vice versa, unless they were dual nominated.

Owner Certification of market animals, with regard to the use of animal health aids, growth promotants or other livestock management substances is required. Please read and understand the following:

- Chemical substances used in livestock production, disease prevention or disease control, have approved withdrawal times.
- Information on specific use and withdrawal times can be found on product label instructions or printed drug lists available from my County Extension Office.
- Tranquilizers and other non-approved substances should not be used for food animals.

The withdrawal date for medication and legal drugs will be the date of animal check-in at the Butler County Fair.

THEREFORE, I certify that the animals I bring to this show, if given animal health aids, growth promotants or other livestock management substances that require withdrawal times, have:
