Requirements:

- Active Butler County 4-H Member
- Must turn 14 years of age during current calendar year
- Must have leadership, community service & public speaking experience
- Complete a Child Abuse Neglect Registry check yearly
- Complete a criminal background check every 3 years

Interviews will be held during October.

All Ambassadors are expected to attend approximately 6-8 meetings per year, help at a variety of county events, and present the Butler County 4-H program at local elementary schools and other venues. An annual schedule showing the majority of required events is below. Ambassadors should be prepared to devote their time and talents to promote the 4-H program and be “the face of 4-H in Butler County.” Please be aware that repeated absences from these obligations may result in an Ambassador being asked to step down.
