

# HUNTER EDUCATION

**PRE-ENROLLMENT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL COURSES.**



The Hunter Education courses are open to anyone. **No fee is required.** No one under the age of 11 will be certified in hunter education. Those under age 11 may take the course with special permission from the instructor. Anyone taking the Hunter Education courses prior to age 11, will be required to take the course again for certification after turning 11.
