

# Hunter Education Traditional Course Instructions

## The 2018 traditional course dates are August 3 & 4



1. You must pre-register for this course at the Butler County Extension Office, 206 North Griffith, 316-321-9660, by the Wednesday before the date scheduled for the course.
2. You should receive 3 items when you register, a Student Manual, this instruction sheet, and a 4-H Shooting Sports Brochure.
3. Prior to the start of the course, you must read the student manual and answer all questions at the end of each section.
4. Check-in will be from 5:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the Friday evening that the course starts. Friday evening's session will be over by about 9:00 p.m. Check-in for Saturday's session will be from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. The course will be over at about 4:00 p.m. There is a lunch break, from 11:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. You must be on time, and attend all sessions in order to be considered for certification.
5. Requirements for passing the course include attending all sessions, showing a positive attitude, following all instructions during the course, demonstrate safe gun handling skills, and passing the written test at the end of the course, on Saturday afternoon.
6. When taking the test, you may not use the manual, notes or any other written materials. If you need assistance in reading the test, an assistant will be provided, if you notify the Extension Office by the Wednesday before the course that you need assistance.
7. Bring a pencil and note paper with you to the course. Also, consider bringing a cushion for your chair.
8. Please be sure that your parent is ready to pick you up promptly at 9:00 p.m. on Friday evening and 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. The sessions may run a little longer, but we want participants ready to depart when the sessions are over. You should not count on being able to leave exactly at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday afternoon. It could be as late as 5:00 p.m., depending on the size of the class.

# Hunter Education Internet Assisted Field Day Course Instructions

## Hunter Education Field Days are September 15

Check-In is from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

Class starts at 8:00 a.m. and will end at about 3:30 p.m.

There will be a lunch break from about 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**During the Field Day, you must demonstrate three things in order to pass the course:**

1. Exhibit a positive attitude at all times.
2. Demonstrate the ability to handle firearms safely.
3. Demonstrate adequate knowledge of hunting safely and ethically by passing the final test at the end of the field day.

### **Prior to the Field Day Day:**

Pick up a student manual and written course instructions at the Extension Office.

You must have access to a computer **AND** a printer in order to complete the online portion of the Internet-Assisted course. **DO NOT REGISTER FOR THE INTERNET-ASSISTED COURSE IF YOU DO NOT HAVE ACCESS TO A COMPUTER AND A PRINTER!**



This independent study method, a three-part process, requires pre-registration in an Internet-Assisted Field Day and Testing Session, completion of the Kansas Online Hunter Education Course AND active participation in a Internet-Assisted Hunter Education Field Day and Testing Session.

**DO NOT TAKE THE ONLINE COURSE UNTIL YOU HAVE PRE-REGISTERED FOR THE INTERNET-ASSISTED HUNTER EDUCATION FIELD DAY AND TESTING SESSION OF YOUR CHOICE.**

1. Pre-register for the field day. (316-321-9660)
2. Go to the Kansas Wildlife, Parks & Tourism website at [ksoutdoors.com](http://ksoutdoors.com)
3. Follow the prompts to access the on-line test and complete it. Education - Hunter Education - Internet Assisted Course - Free Kansas Internet Assisted Course (Yellow box at the bottom of the page) - take the test.
4. After completing the test, print the completion certificate and bring it with you to the course.
