Dear 4-H'ers, Parents and Leaders:

This letter contains instructions and forms for the Butler County Fair Fashion Revue. **It will be held at El Dorado High School, 401 McCollum Road on Saturday, July 14, 2018.** *Please note: (1)clothing construction judging WILL take place at Fashion Revue again this year.*

1) SCHEDULE (refer to page 6 of the 2018 Butler Co. Fair Book for times)

- **Doors will open at 7:00 a.m.**
- **NOTE a change in time for Public Fashion Revue – it will be held at 1:30 p.m.**

2) GENERAL EVENT NOTES:

- READ the Fair Book page 42 for Fashion Revue and page 36 for Clothing Construction. These pages also contain your class number for pre-entry.
- Times will be pre-scheduled
- Additional event notes, details and the schedule will be mailed out the week following pre-entry deadline and can also be found here: <http://www.butler.k-state.edu/4hfair/>
- Clothing Construction judging will take place the same day. Those modeling their Constructed outfit in Fashion Revue must enter their constructed garments in clothing construction judging that immediately follows the modeling.
 - If you are modeling a constructed outfit please note that a majority of your outfit must be constructed (Rule 7, Page 42)
 - Clothing Construction Fashion Revue **REQUIRES** a pre-entry.
 - Clothing Construction judging (separate of the Fashion Revue **DOES NOT** require pre-entry)

3) PRE-ENTRY INFORMATION

- **Fashion Revue pre-entry: SCRIPTS ONLY REQUIRED.** Script forms are included in this letter. You can model up to 2 outfits
- **DUE – Friday, June 29th, 5:00 p.m.** to the Butler County Extension Office – 206 N. Griffith, El Dorado, KS 67042
- Late Entries **WILL NOT** be accepted.
- The 4-H Fashion Revue Evaluation score card is included and you must fill one out for EACH outfit and bring it with you to the Judging. A photo of the 4-H'er in their outfit **must be attached** to each 4-H Fashion Revue Evaluation score card. **DO NOT** Turn these in with pre-entries.
