4-H BUCKET CALF TAGGING

It is time to plan for your bucket calf tagging! All bucket calves must be tagged by 6:00 p.m. on April 27th, 2023 in order to be eligible to be exhibited at the 2023 Butler County Fair. You have 2 options for tagging.

1. **Option #1** – Bring them to the beef county tagging on February 27th between 7:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. at the Flinthills High School FFA Ag Facility, 806 SE Rosalia Rd, Rosalia, KS 67132
2. **Option #2** – Bring them to the small animal tagging events. These will be held on April 23rd between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. and on April 27th between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. This will be held at the Butler County Extension Office. If you have other small livestock (sheep, meat goat, swine, dairy goats) that need tagged, they can all be tagged at the same time.

The tag cost will be \$4.00 and must be paid by cash or check at the time of tagging; please bring exact change.

Requirements:

- ✓ **YQCA:** YQCA is REQUIRED to be eligible to exhibit ALL ANIMAL PROJECTS (Except Horses) at the 2023 Butler County Fair and must be completed by June 1st, 2023 to be eligible to participate. YQCA information can be found at: <https://www.butler.k-state.edu/4-h/YQCA.html>
- ✓ **ENROLLMENT:** Please double check that your 4-H members are enrolled in 4-H for the 2022-2023 year and also enrolled in the Bucket Calf Project by May 1st, 2023.
- ✓ **ONE (1) FORM FOR BUCKET CALVES:** Animal Care & Housing. Make sure all family 4-H members that could possibly show the calf and Parent/Guardians sign the form.
