4-H BUCKET CALF TAGGING

It is time to schedule your bucket calf tagging. All bucket calves must be tagged by 6:00 p.m. on April 28th, 2022 in order to be eligible to be exhibited at the 2022 Butler County Fair. You have 2 options for tagging.

- Option #1 Bring them to the county tagging on April 28th between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. or 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Butler County Extension Office, or schedule a time with Charlene Miller to tag them at the Extension Office.
- Option #2 Call the Extension Office at (316) 321-9660 to schedule a time for Charlene to come out and tag them at your location during the hours of M F 8:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m. If you have other small livestock (sheep, meat goat, swine, dairy goats) that need tagged, they can all be tagged at the same time.

Please note that bucket calves will not receive an EID tag this year. They will be tagged with a different 4-H tag. Tag cost will be \$2 per tag.

Requirements:

- ✓ YQCA: YQCA is <u>REQUIRED</u> to be eligible to exhibit <u>ALL ANIMAL PROJECTS</u> (Except Horses) at the 2022 Butler County Fair and must be completed by June 1st, 2022 to be eligible to participate. YQCA information can be found at: <u>https://www.butler.k-state.edu/4-h/YQCA.html</u>
- ✓ ENROLLMENT: Please double check that your 4-H members are enrolled in 4-H for the 2021-2022 year and are also enrolled in the Bucket Calf Project by May 1st, 2022.
- ✓ ONE (1) FORMS FOR BUCKET CALVES: Animal Care & Housing. Make sure all 4-H members and Parent/Guardians sign the form.
