A basic shotgun class will be held Saturday, April 27 at Michael Murphy and Sons, 6400 SW Hunter Road, Augusta.

Minimum age for participation is 12 years old. However, if you are younger than 12, but strong enough to handle your shotgun, you may still participate by getting prior approval from the lead instructors:

NOTE: Completion of both the shooting sports enrollment form by April 24 and enrolling in 4-H online by April 18 is mandatory. You will not be allowed to shoot if you have not fulfilled these requirements.

The course will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 27, and will end at approximately 3:00 p.m. Do not show up without being preregistered **and** enrolled through 4-H Online. Ammunition, targets, and range fees are provided. Bring your own lunch and drink. Coolers will be provided. You may bring your own shotgun, if you have one. The

preferred choke is IC – improved cylinder or more open. 410's are not suitable for beginner instruction.
