

Livestock Show and Sale Changes!

Due to the Vesicular Stomatitis - VSV - being in the county and the information coming out from the Department of Agriculture, no animals will be allowed on the fairgrounds until they have been inspected in the trailers by a qualified, licensed and accredited veterinarian.

Please refer to the updated fair schedule that has been posted and sent out by the Extension Office and Fair Board. There are a lot of changes!!!

- No trailers or animals allowed on the fairgrounds the night before their show. No animals can be unloaded until checked by a veterinarian.
- Animals will be checked-in prior to their respective show. Please review the schedule for times designated for each species.
- Market animals must weigh in at designated times for each species on their designated day. No late weigh ins allowed.
- Animals will show on their designated day and time, out of their trailers. Pens are available for those who prefer to use them.
- If using a pen, you are responsible for your bedding and clean up.
- Wash racks will be available. You are responsible for your own supplies, hoses, and clean up.

No Animals Will Be at the Livestock Sale

Animals will either go base bid to the packer or go home the day of the show.

- Base bid animals must be declared within 1 hour after each show. Base bid buyers will be at the fairgrounds to pick animals up on day of show.
- Carcass beef – information will be provided by the Extension Office
- You must declare which species you will sell in the auction within 1 hour after the Beef Show on Tuesday. This will allow the youth that show several species to choose which to use in sale. If only showing 1 species, please sign up for the sale within 1 hour after specific show or once you have shown all your species. Please designate as soon as possible. This will expedite things for the sale bill and sale night.

- Sign up for base bids and sale will be outside the show ring. You must know your animal tag number when signing up.
- After your show has ended, those animals that are designated to be in the auction must have their picture taken with the backdrop. These photos will be used during the sale to show your animal. If you are declaring which species to sell after the beef show, photos will be taken of each animal and then added to sale slide show once decision is made on Tuesday or after your last species shown.

- Wednesday 7:00 p.m. Livestock Sale. 4-H youth selling livestock please arrive to the fairgrounds by 6:30 p.m.
- 4-Hers must be present to sell in the Livestock Sale.
- All sale designated livestock must include tag number of animal declared and going through the sale.
- Sale schedule order: Meat Goats, Sheep, Beef, Swine
- Livestock Sale – we are working on having a combined in-person and online livestock sale this year. More information to come.
