Requirements:

- Active Butler County 4-H Member
- Must turn 14 years of age by January 1st of the current 4-H year
- Must have leadership, community service & public speaking experience
- Complete a criminal background check every 3 years

*Interviews will be held during October.

As an Ambassador, you will be needed to attend approximately 6-8 meetings per year; you will also be able to help at a variety of county events, and present the Butler County 4-H program at local elementary schools and other venues! The schedule below shows the majority of required events.
